

Weyauwega-Fremont 17, Amherst 0

AMHERST -- Amherst had a rare performance where its running attack outgained its passing attack, but 112 yards from Skylar Trzebiatowski couldn't get the Falcons in the end zone.

The sophomore running back rushed 19 times for the game-high total, but the Falcons had trouble finishing and maintaining drives.

"We were able to move the ball, but penalties costed us," Amherst coach Brian Toelle said. The biggest call for the Falcons was a holding penalty that erased a game-tying field goal.

A 3-0 Weyauwega-Fremont halftime lead extended with two scores in the fourth, a 25-yard Kyle Bosquez touchdown run and a 32-yard interception returned for a touchdown by Josh Buckholz. Weyauwega-Fremont picked off Amherst QB Nate Martin three times.

"It was a good game all-around, some things didn't go our way, but we had our chances to win the game," Toelle said.
