## Roundup: Amherst nabs only second win over Witt-Birn

WITTENBERG -- For only the second time in its program's history Amherst football pulled out a win against Wittenberg-Birnamwood.

In jumping out to a 14-0 lead in the first quarter the Chargers were primed to make this another routine matchup with the Falcons but Amherst turned things around quickly, scoring 27 unanswered points.

Nate Martin, known mostly as a passer, had his best rushing game of the season. The junior quarterback tallied 112 yards and scored twice on the ground on top of 121 yards and a touchdown through the air.

"We've been running Nate more in recent weeks, it gives us another dimension that we're trying to add," Amherst coach Brian Toelle said.

Also stepping up was Scott Van Nuys who scored on a pass and a run, the sophomore led Amherst with 37 yards receiving and made 47 yards rushing.

"We were able to finish drives tonight, that was big, we put the ball over (the goal line)," Toelle said.
